

LBC ON THE LAWN: Guidelines and Instructions

Thank you for your interest in our *Church on the Lawn* service! Here are a few guidelines to help make the event most enjoyable and glorifying to the Lord:

General Guidelines:

1. It is our desire to continue to take proper precautions to prevent the spreading of the virus. If you are not feeling well, please stay home. We will be streaming the service at 9:30 a.m. and recording it for later viewing.
2. If you belong to an *at risk group* or are simply uncomfortable with gathering at this time, please do not feel obligated to attend in person. Join us by live streaming or watch the recording.
3. While we encourage everyone to come prepared for an hour long service, restrooms will be available if needed. Please enter through the main Skylight entrance doorways. Restrooms will be monitored to allow for use by one individual or family at a time. (hand sanitizer and masks are available if needed)
4. By now we are familiar with the guidelines and precautions for maintaining social distance. We expect everyone to follow the guidelines and to respect one another in this regard. Even though we are outdoors, masks are encouraged, but not required. If you're unable to maintain proper social distance, please use a mask. Please bring your own mask. If you do not have one or forget yours, please see an usher and they can provide you with one.
5. In case of inclement weather we will be sending out an email blast and updating the website as early as practical. If you are in doubt, please check the website or your email before heading to church. Should the outdoor service be cancelled, we will stream it live from the sanctuary so that you can watch it from home. The sanctuary will not be open to the congregation during this time.

Seating

1. Shaded Seating: We will have shaded seating under the large tree by the driveway. This is provided for the elderly, or others with needs. If you are in need of assistance, please let an usher know.
2. Open Seating: There is open seating in the middle of the field. It is BYOE (Bring Your Own Everything - chairs, water, sunscreen, blankets, bug spray). Please space yourselves at the proper social distance that would be expected at the beach. If you're using an umbrella, please sit near the back of the field to allow good sightlines for others.
3. Family Seating: We will have some pop up tents to provide shade for families with infants and young children near the pebble patio. Please bring your own chairs. Check out our [video](#) and resource page for tips on our family inclusive service!
4. The service will be streamed live on YouTube. Visit lincroftbiblechurch.org/livestream to access the feed. The service will also be recorded and posted for later viewing.
